





St. Charles Episcopal Church has over a 25 year history of feeding our neighbors in the Fox Valley community.

A Fundraiser is being held at the Wine Exchange in St. Charles to help us continue feeding those in need. Included will be: six wine tastings, hors d'oeuvres, Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite, and infused water. There will also be raffle baskets and silent auctions. Select light dinner menu items will be available for purchase. Wine will also be available to purchase by the glass or by the bottle. This event is open to the public, family and friends.

Feeding Ministries:

- The Free Spaghetti Dinner is held once a month and serves over 200 meals with meals going to Carroll Towers and Lazarus House.
- The Hesed House ministry serves over 200 individuals in Aurora with a hot breakfast and a sack lunch once a month.
- The Sandwich Board is now making over 400 sandwiches once a month for the Trinity Church distribution in Aurora.

- Lazarus House in St. Charles receives 30 hot meals once a month and another 30 spaghetti meals once a month.
